Introduction

We provide a flexible menu of inspiring and enjoyable courses and community workshops that can be adapted to suit your needs and delivered at a time and place of your choice. They can take place as stand-alone one-off sessions, or scheduled into a programme of activities for a larger event such as a festival or community celebration. A number of sessions could also be linked together and used as a way of getting the whole community involved in preparations for a carnival or lantern parade.

Who are they for?

All of our courses and workshops are suitable for a wide range of people of different ages with varying levels of skill and ability. Groups that we have past experience of working with include:

- Children and young people
- Festival and carnival groups
- Families
- Women
- People with mental health problems
- People with learning difficulties

We are also interested in sharing our skills, experience and resources with youth and other community leaders who would like to provide more creative opportunities themselves and have developed a number of sessions that are tailored to this particular need.

How much do our courses and workshops cost?

The price list, on the last page of the brochure, covers the various charges for different types of courses and workshops that we run. Our charges will depend on:

- how many people are involved
- how many artists are needed to deliver the workshop/course
- the status of the group that is putting on the workshop/course.

Wherever possible we try to include all the costs of materials and travel etc in the fee. We leave it up to each organisation to decide whether they wish to fund the full costs of workshops themselves (possibly through a grant) and/or make a charge for participants. We are open to exploring the provision of workshops and courses that are entirely funded by individuals paying for themselves.

When and where do they take place?

Our courses and workshops can be delivered at a venue, time and place of your choice. We are happy to run sessions anywhere in Pembrokeshire and potentially further a field. We can provide sessions during weekdays, in the evenings and at weekends.

Courses and workshops for youth and community leaders

A range of introductory practical courses that can be tailored to meet the specific needs of groups of youth and community workers.

C1 Carnivals, Parades and Festivals

A practical course providing opportunities to find out about a range of techniques and materials and resources to create a visual impact in community celebrations

C2 Tools of the trade: Developing skills and techniques

A practical course focussing on developing a range of skills and techniques and exploring how these can be used in different settings. Techniques covered could include: mark-making, drawing, painting, printing and collage

C3 Make it: Simple 3D design projects

A practical course sharing the skills, techniques and resources needed for a range of simple 3D design projects such as: lanterns, windsocks, masks and mobiles

C4 Working Creatively: space to create

An opportunity for staff to take some time out from everyday pressures to work together using a range of arts based exercises to open up creative possibilities and new ways of thinking. A fun and inspirational way to build team spirit and replenish your organisation's most vital resource.

Community Workshops

Outlines of a selection of 10 creative workshops grouped under the titles "Make it "(**M**) and "Explore"(**E**). These workshops can all be tailored to suit a wide range of needs and abilities.

M1 Make it: *from the beach*

Working with found materials *from the beach* and learning basic joining and construction techniques to make a driftwood sculpture or mobile

M2 Make it: *lanterns*

Working with willow withies, masking tape, wet strength tissue paper and pva to construct and decorate lanterns for a parade or outdoor decoration

M3 Make it: *banners and flags*

Working with fabric and re-enforced papers to design and make flags and banners individually and in groups as decorations for special occasions or to raise awareness of a particular issue

M4 Make it: *windsocks*

Working with paper, paints, string, wire and glue to design and make colourful hand-held windsocks for a procession or display

M5 Make it: *masks*

Working with a range of scrap and recycled materials to construct masks based on a chosen theme

E1 Explore *collage*

Working with newspapers, magazines, textiles and assorted paper to explore the creative possibilities of collage using a chosen theme

E2 Explore *the senses*

Working with a range of materials such as inks, pastels, charcoal, pencils and crayons to explore creative responses to each of the senses in turn

- E3 Explore self-expression**
Working with paint to explore the creative possibilities of self-expression using a range of stimuli eg music, poetry etc as a starting point to inspire the imagination
- E4 Explore print**
Working with a range of techniques, tools and equipment to explore the creative possibilities of print
- E5 Explore clay**
Working with clay to explore its qualities and creative possibilities

All workshops are designed to accommodate roughly 15 people participating at one time and are suitable for drop-in. The prices include all materials and transport costs, but exclude venue and refreshments costs. A half day is a maximum of 4 hours including setting up and clearing away time and a whole day is a maximum of 8 hours including setting up and clearing away with a minimum 45 min break for the artist if the contact time with participants is more than 4 hours.
